

Slouchy Socks- adapted from Red Heart pattern

Yarn: Plymouth Aireado Duet-1 skein (283 Yds)

Needles: Size 10 dble pts.

Guage: 3.5 sts= 1”

Sizes: Med (Lg)- sample is large size

Cast on 28 (36) sts and join in the round.

Rounds 1-3: K1, P1 around.

Leg:

Rounds 1-4: Purl

Rounds 5-7: Knit

Repeat rounds 1-7 5 more times

Knit 3 rounds



After Thought Heel

With scrap. Yarn (cotton if possible)

Knit first 14 sts.

Slip sts back to left hand needle and using main yarn knit across scrap yarn and to beginning of round.

Foot

Knit in round until foot measures 8 1/2 (9 1/2)” - or 1 1/2” short of foot length.

(I worked 32 rounds)

Toe

Distribute on 4 double pts. -

7 (9) sts per needle.

Round 1

Needle 1: K1, SSK, knit to end of needle.

Needle 2: knit to last 3 sts on needle 2, K2tog, K1

Needle 3: work as for needle 1

Needle 4: work as for needle 2

Round 2

Knit all

Repeat round 1 and 2 until 12 (16) sts remain

Knit needle 1

Work kitchner with decrease at outsides of both needles.

Afterthought Heel

Remove waste yarn and place resulting sts on 4 dbl pts decided evenly

Rejoin yarn

Needle 1: K1, SSK, knit to end of needle.

Needle 2: knit to last 3 sts on needle 2, K2tog, K1

Needle 3: work as for needle 1

Needle 4: work as for needle 2

Row 2: Knit all

Repeat last 2 round until 12 sts remain. Kitchner heel.
